

Our Museum Staff Questionnaire

CLARIFICATION: Communities refers to collections of people, including organisations that are connected by interest, location, culture or particular characteristics. For the purposes of this questionnaire and Our Museum remit, we are focusing Bristol-based communities.

5. What benefits do communities bring to your area of work?
6. How has your work had an impact on the development of community skills?
7. How have communities had an impact on the development of your own skills?
8. What support do you need to work in partnership with communities?
